

Our response to the Novel Coronavirus epidemic

(Announced on April 7, 2020)

1 Exhibition space fees will be fully refunded.

If IPF Japan 2020 is canceled under the discretion of the organizer, the organizer will refund the full amount.

2 No cancellation fees will be charged.

If an exhibitor decides not to participate in IPF Japan 2020, the organizer will not charge any cancellation fees.

According to the IPF Japan 2020 general regulations, a 50% cancellation fee will be charged for exhibition space after April 4, and 100% on or after June 1, but as this is a special case, no cancellation fees will be charged regardless of the date.

3 Exhibition applications will be accepted even after April 3.

Applications will be accepted even after the deadline of April 3, which was originally announced.

However, due to our floor plan announcement is scheduled before the end of June, booth location request after April 20 will not be taken into consideration.

4 A decision will be made to postpone or cancel on June 1.

On June 1, we will decide and make an announcement as to whether or not IPF Japan will be held as scheduled, postponed or canceled, and we will inform the exhibitors. Depending on the circumstances, we may delay the final decision, but we will also inform the exhibitors.

5 We will make an effort to judge and operate in order to protect the interests of exhibitors.

If the organizer decides that the exhibition cannot achieve its goals, the exhibition will be canceled / postponed. We will not force-hold the event and bring damage to our exhibitors if low attendance is projected.

We believe that our exhibitors are worried about the upcoming situation. Shutting down everything would damage the economy too badly to recover even after the pandemic ends. Making a decision and taking steps now might lead your business to recovering faster in the future.

There is no cancellation fees, so apply with confidence.
