From Airport by Bus



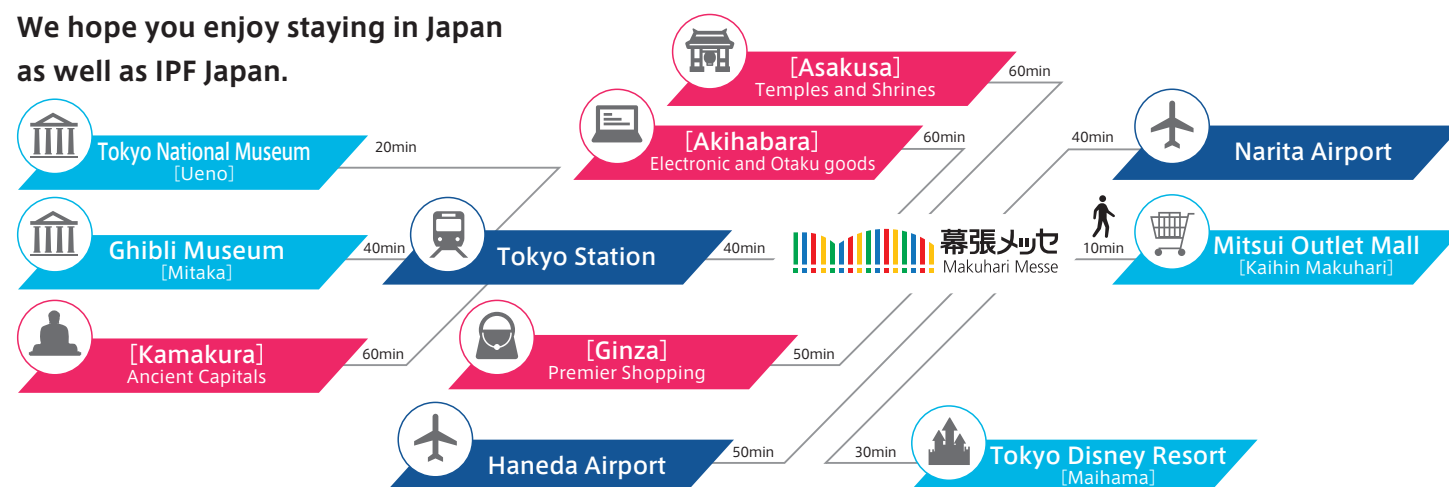
